Directions and map to Jawbone Station:

- From Bakersfield and Central Valley --- take Hwy 58 east to intersection of I-14 just north of Mojave, CA and drive 17 miles north to Jawbone Station

- From the LA area --- take I-14 north from Palmdale to Mojave and about 20 miles north to Jawbone Station
- From Owens Valley --- Take U.S. 395 south toward Mojave, CA turning right (west) onto Jawbone Canyon Road to Jawbone Station BLM Facility just south of Red Rock Canyon State Park
- From Inland Empire --- Take I-15/U.S. 395 north to Kramer Corners at intersection of Hwy 58, drive west to Mojave and to take I-14 north to Jawbone Station, 17 miles north of intersection with I-14.
